The initiative came in the 1950s from three nations - India, Yugoslavia and Egypt respectively represented by the three statesmen -Nehru, Tito and Nasser. From its modest beginnings at the Belgrade Conference in 1961, with a participation of 25 nations, the Non-Aligned Movement has expanded to include 114 nations in the Kuala Lumpur Summit Conference in 2003.
